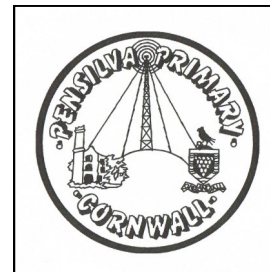

Harvest Foodbank—letter from the Project Manager

I am writing to thank you all so much for the generous donation of food to the Liskeard and Looe Foodbank from your recent Harvest Festival. We weighed it in at 25.1kg which will provide at least 3 days of food to 2 people.

We are extremely grateful for your continued support in this work which shows no sign of reducing with more and more people struggling to put food on the table.

In the last 12 months we have given out 19 tonnes of emergency food boxes, containing at least 3 days of food, to 1700 local people including 600 children. This represents a 10% increase on the previous 12 months.

As you can imagine this is an increasingly challenging logistical exercise, which without the many wonderful volunteers would be an impossible task.

We are very thankful for all who contribute in whatever way they can. Please pass on our thanks to the children and parents.
