



Reception and Key Stage One are presenting "Hooray in a Manger" this year on Monday 16th December at 1.30pm and Tuesday 17th December at 6pm.



Tickets will be available from the school office from now until Friday 6th December.




Initially, there will be two tickets per family per performance. If there are any spare tickets they will be available from Monday 9th December — maximum 2 per family.
