## Writing task Tuesday 2nd and Wednesday 3rd June

You are a prisoner arriving on Alcatraz- give a detailed description of your journey, feelings, thoughts and first impressions of your new home. How do you settle and spend your first night?

Writing to Model at the beginning of the lesson – point out interesting features (tasting things that aren't food, feeling things that aren't physical, personification of the walls and the birds, WOW words, how negative it is). Point out that it is in the present tense, as if it is happening now. Look at the punctuation used. It could be improved with question marks maybe? Explain that explanation marks might not be appropriate because they show excitement – full stops, ellipses and question marks would be much more suitable.
