Neville Chamberlain declared war on Germany because they took some of Europe and would not stop. It happened 3rd of September 1939.

All the adults were allowed to pick two children each out of the 100 adults and 200 children. The teachers only had three children left after an hour. 2 other adults came and picked Noah Capote and Eliza Beach and there was one left Jeff Roberto and no adults left so the billeting officer went to houses. 7 knocks later there was an old man that took pity on them.

After the announcement all the children were being evacuated to the countryside. All of the pregnant woman was pleased that they didn't have to help the men in the war, to build bombs and cannons. The health service for children went for their health and protection. They all were crying and not wanting to leave their family. Most of the mothers were reluctant to send their children to the countryside.

The train was moving fast and the evacuees were being sick out the windows and in sick bags. One of the evacuees Jeff Roberto said, "I was feeling worried about who I was going to stay and all the other children were feeling the same suffering high-levels of home sickness which is a lot of vomit."

Other evacuees had a different opinion. Noah Capote reported, "I was feeling excited about going somewhere new to see new animals and pets that my caretaker might have. I'm a bit worried and excited about going to new places, but I'll miss my family so very much."
