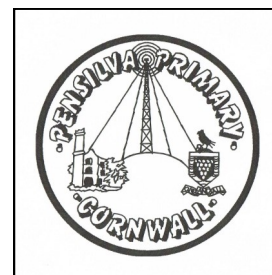

To Live, To Love, To Learn

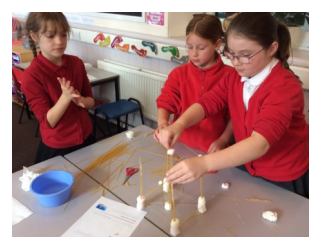


Thank you to everybody who came to our coffee and open morning today and to all those who baked and donated cakes and biscuits.

Keeping Our Children Safe



We would like to reintroduce a voluntary one-way system around the school block for morning drop-off and end of day pick-up times.

In the past, this has been successful in not only keeping our children safe but also keeping the traffic flowing easily during these busy times.

We would appreciate your support in adopting this voluntary one-system.

In practice, this would mean turning into School Road and after drop-off/pick-up, continuing in the direction of the cemetery and turning right following the road to join Slade Park Road to re-join Princess Street at the Victoria Inn.

We will be writing to all our neighbours to inform them of our intended voluntary system. Thank you for your co-operation and support.
