Wrens class

Buzzards have had another very busy week. This week we have been developing our diary writing skills. We have explored time adverbials and the writing characteristics that we need to include. We are basing our diary writing on the book we have been reading in our VIPERS sessions. In maths, we have continued to explore our knowledge of numbers and place value, working with numbers to a million. We have completed a 'Gig' in Times Table Rockstars so we can again regularly log in to the 'Studio' and increase the fluency of our multiplication tables recall.

We've found out about 'Accelerated Reader' and have chosen our first reading books as part of the program. One child in the class completed her first quiz and scored 100% - wow! In computing, we focused on Internet safety. We watched a film, engaged in lots of discussion, and then collaborated to create Internet safety posters. We have found out more about 'Growth Mindset' and are trying to adopt this as a positive approach to our learning.

Mrs. Sissons has continued to be impressed by our hard work and the good choices made by both individuals and the whole class on lots of occasions throughout the week.


