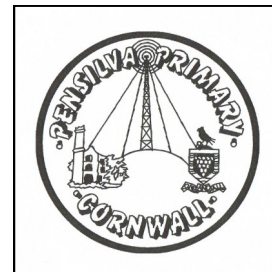

Reception and Key Stage One are presenting "Hooray in a Manger" this year on Monday 16th December at 1.30pm and Tuesday 17th December at 6pm.

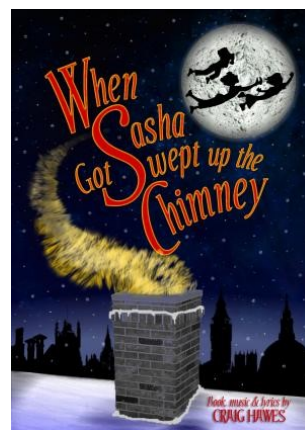
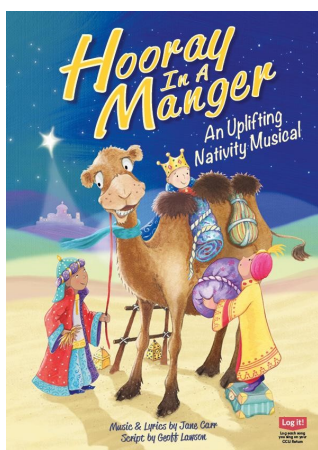
