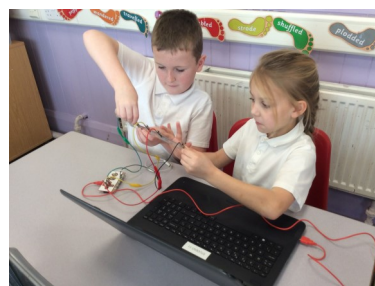
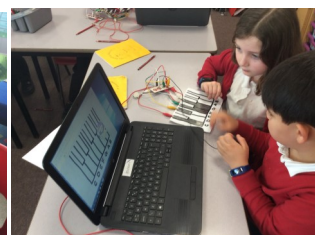
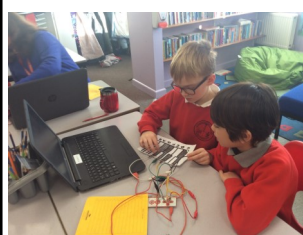


### To Live, To Love, To Learn
