Wrens class

At the end of last term we celebrated our Great Fire of London topic by recreating the great fire using our junk modelling houses! The children were amazing and all sung London's burning as the houses burned. We also took some of the houses away to create a fire break.

Doves class

This week we have been learning about plants and seeds in Science. The children went outside to look at the different wild plants growing around the school. They found out about how seeds are dispersed and the features that help them to be dispersed in this way. We have also learnt about what pollen is and how it makes new plants. Puffins class

This term in geography we will be learning about water. We will focus on the water cycle and explore the processes of evaporation and condensation through a range of practical activities. By considering water as a finite resource, we will explore the ideas of conservation and consider some of the issues surrounding supplying clean drinking water to a growing global population.

We are also having swimming lessons for the next six weeks. Our first session was a real success with all children finishing the lesson with a smile on their faces. It was wonderful to hear the children discuss the importance of water safety and the fun activities that you can take part in the water. Puffin Class demonstrated an excellent attitude and were a real credit to Pensilva Primary School. Well done!

Buzzards and Puffins Class

At the end of last term, both classes were visited by Lifeguards who taught them about keeping safe. The children took part in activities focusing on keeping safe when visiting the sea; what their flags mean on beaches, rip currents and what to do if they find themselves struggling in the sea. It was a really lively session with the opportunities to role play and to volunteer to dress up! The children were impressive with their knowledge by the end. Please talk to your child about beach and water safety as we enjoy our environment in the summer months.

Buzzards Class

This week the Year 5s have been working on developing formal methods for multiplication. The Year 6s have continued practising for their SATS tests. In English we have been exploring how to use a range of conjunctions to organise ideas in our writing in response to the film narrative 'Dreamgiver'.

We have also begun a focus on presentation and editing our work: 'Think Pink!'.
