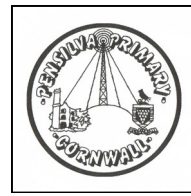

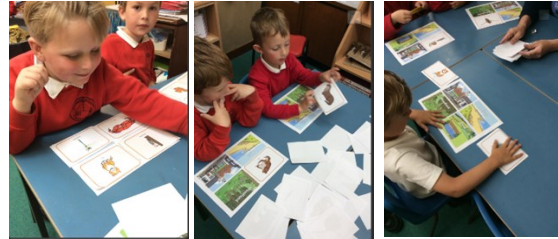

Wrens class

In science we have been learning about animals and their habitats. The children all played a game where they had to sort the animals into their correct habitats. We loved the game and learnt about some new plants and animals that we didn't know much about.



Doves class

Despite the awful weather on Wednesday, Doves had an amazing time at Forest School. We took it in turns to lead our blindfolded partners around the Forest School area. The



children had to use their communication skills to ensure their partners were safe and to let them know when to duck, step up or move around an obstacle. Some children had great ideas about how to communicate with their partners such as leading them by the hand, talking to them or placing their partners hands on their shoulders to lead them around. After the children had done this in their pairs, they made a human millipede and were lead around by one child at the front. Whatever the leader said, the others had to feed back to the rest of the line so that the children knew when to step, duck or go around any objects!

Puffins and Buzzards Class

This week we have made and used salt dough to create our plaques to sell at our summer fair. We created a shape and then added intricate flower details. Once the mixture had been baked in an oven, we let them cool and then carefully painted our designs.

How to make salt dough

Makes 1 ball

Prep 10 minutes

Cook 3 hours

- 1 cupful of plain flour (about 250g)
- half a cupful of table salt (about 125g)
- half a cupful of water (about 125ml)

1. Preheat the oven to its lowest setting and line a baking sheet with baking parchment.
2. Mix the flour and salt in a large bowl. Add the water and stir until it comes together into a ball.
3. Transfer the dough to a floured work surface and shape into your chosen model.
4. Put your finished items on the lined baking sheet and bake for 3 hrs or until solid.
5. Leave to cool and then paint.
