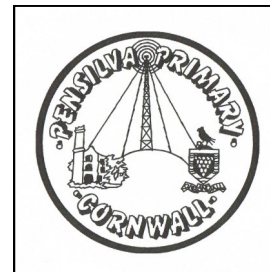

Improving School Communications with ParentMail

From 1st November 2018 we will be upgrading to ParentMail.

The benefits to this are that we now send Communications home through ParentMail as well as a free, secure mobile App for you to pick up school communications on the go!

PMX will be beneficial to you because you can:

- * Use a free, secure mobile app on Android and iOS to pick up school messages instantly.
- * Have an account simply for school messages (away from your busy email inbox!)
- * Connect to other schools, nurseries or clubs that use ParentMail.
- * Highlight important messages or archive old messages to make life easier.
- * Messages can be sent directly to mums, dads and carers – even grandparents!
- * Update your contact details within the secure mobile app.

Registering with ParentMail is very easy! Once our current system (call parents) migrates to ParentMail, you will be sent either an email and/or text message from ParentMail, when you receive this please just follow the instructions in the message.

Once registered, if you have an Android or Apple smartphone, we would highly recommend you download the ParentMail App for the best user experience. To do this, simply search for “ParentMail” in your App store.

Please be assured that ParentMail is registered with the Information Commissioner and guarantees that all information you provide will be kept private and will not be passed on to any other organisation.
