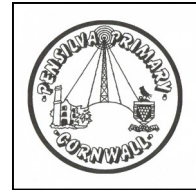

Liskeard Library invite your child to join the Summer Reading Challenge 2021. If your child has not joined the library or perhaps has an unused library card at home, we would like to encourage them to take part in this year's challenge, 'Wild World Heroes'.

Summer Reading Challenge 2021



Presented by The Reading Agency.  
Delivered in partnership with libraries.

Children's reading can 'dip' during the long summer holidays. The annual Summer Reading Challenge helps get three quarters of a million children into libraries to keep up their reading skills and confidence. The Summer Reading Challenge encourages children aged 4 to 11 to read six books during the long summer holiday.

It is a fun free activity for children to take part in, with prizes and stickers to collect throughout the challenge. For all children who complete the challenge there is a medal and certificate, the certificate will be presented at school in the autumn term. Signing up to the challenge is really easy; just bring your children to any library from Saturday 10th July. Following the new law regarding data collection and use, we will be asking you to sign a personal data statement.

The challenge finishes on Saturday 11th September so make sure to visit Liskeard Library again before school starts.

Liskeard Library is still located temporarily at Luxstowe House, Liskeard to allow for a refurbishment to take place. Once this refurbishment has been completed, the Library will return to Barras Street.

We look forward to welcoming children to the library this summer.
