

If your child has not joined the library or perhaps has an unused library card at home, we would like to encourage them to take part in this year's challenge, 'Space Chase'.



The Summer Reading Challenge encourages children aged 4 to 11 to read six books during the long summer holiday. It is a fun free activity for children to take part in, with prizes and stickers to collect throughout the challenge.

For all children who complete the challenge there is a medal and certificate, the certificate will be presented at school in the autumn term.

Signing up to the challenge is really easy; just bring your children to any library from Saturday 13 th July. Following the new law regarding data collection and use, we will be asking you to sign a personal data statement. The challenge finishes on Saturday 14th September.
