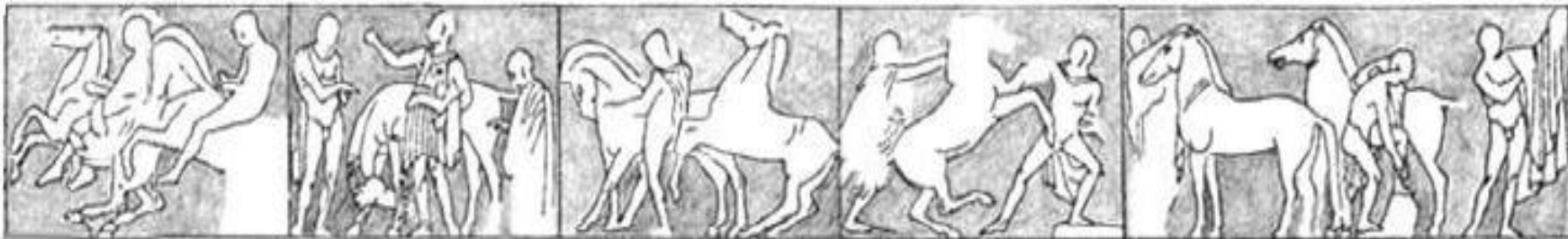


The Parthenon cella frieze story

West side

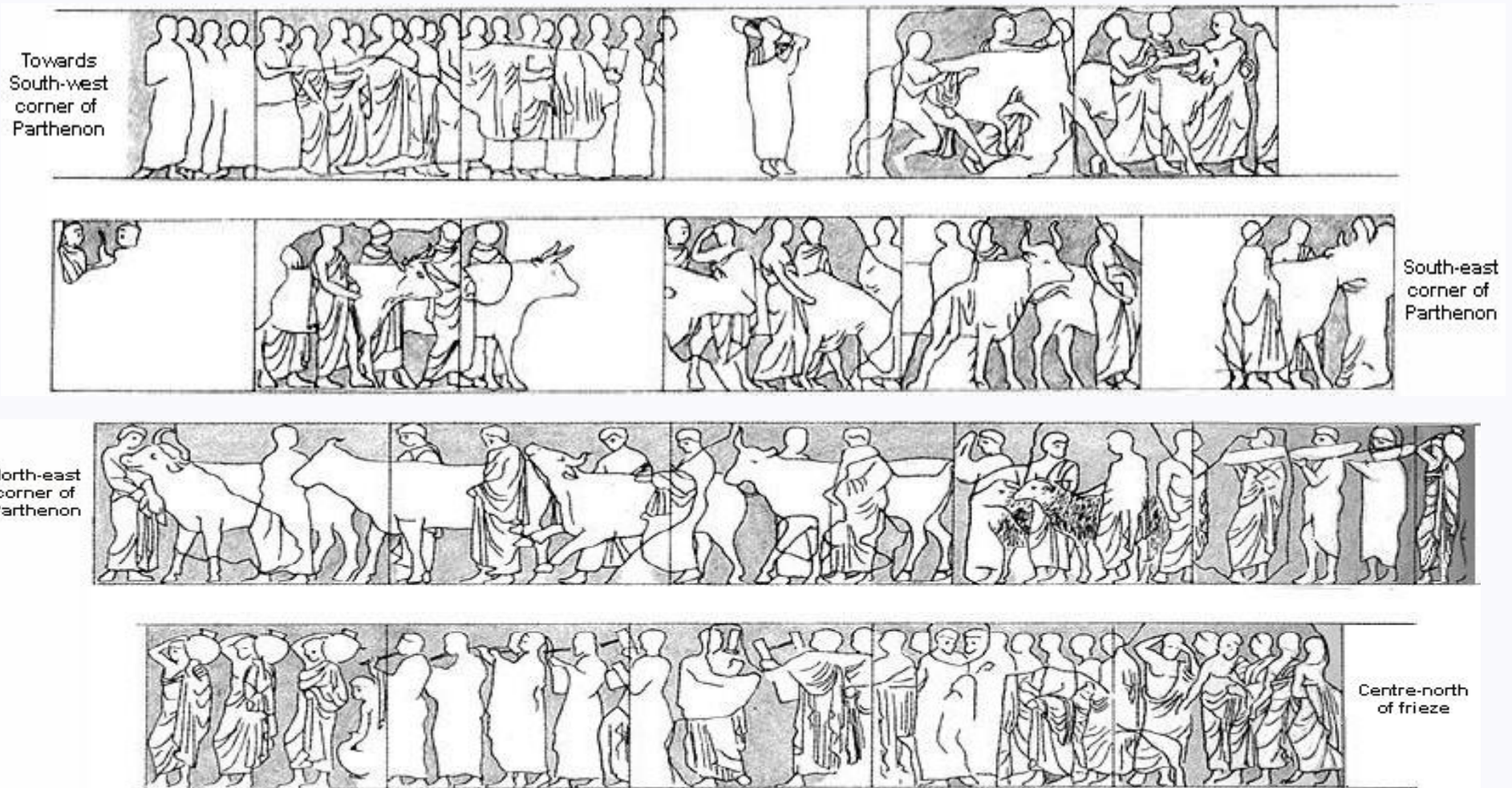
North-west

Parthenon

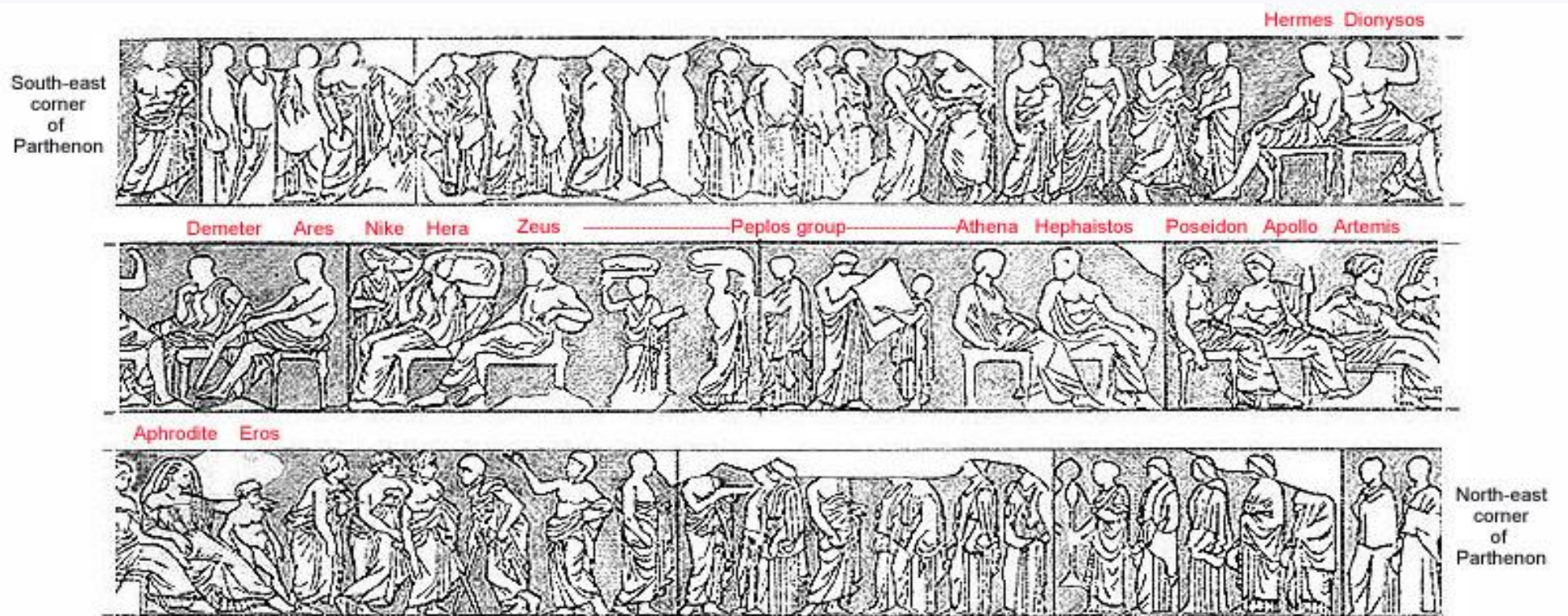
This is the start of the procession – people are trying to get on their horses.

North and South sides



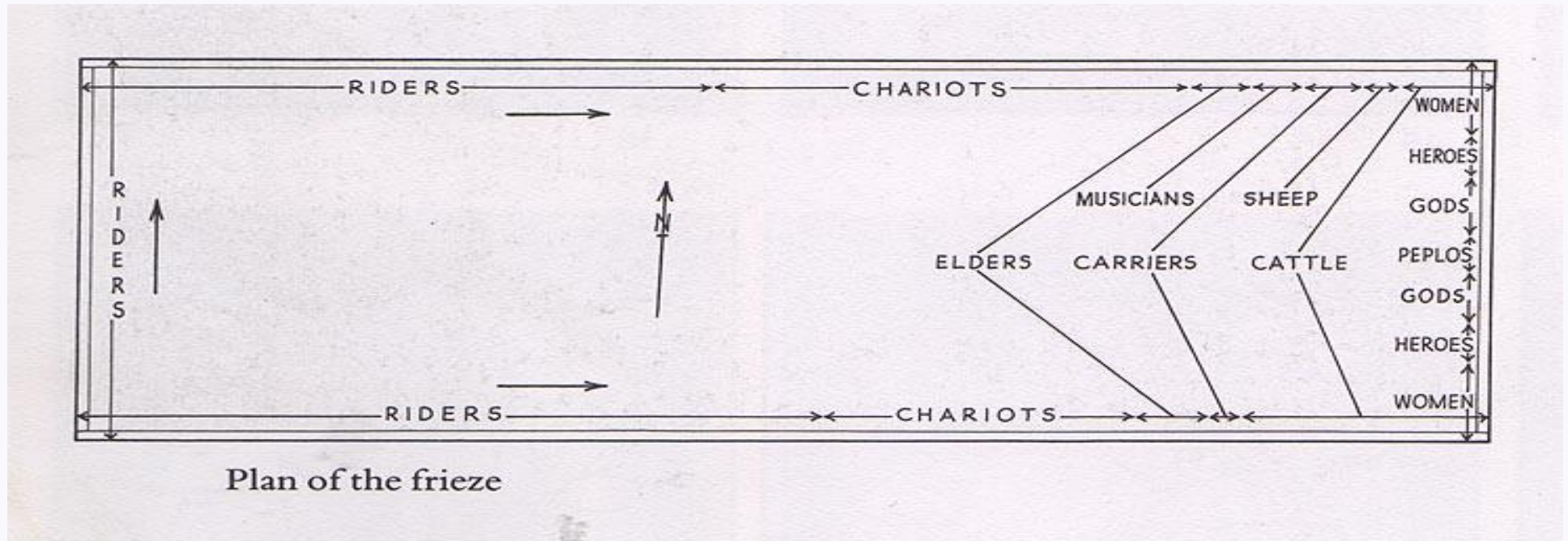
A lot of these are missing, but there are Athenian elders walking behind the animals being taken to be sacrificed to Athena.

There are women on both ends of the east side, behind Greek heroes from myths and legend. The gods are seated on either side of men and women bringing the peplos to Athena.
