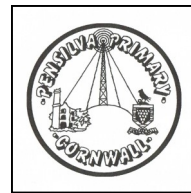

Does it look appetising?

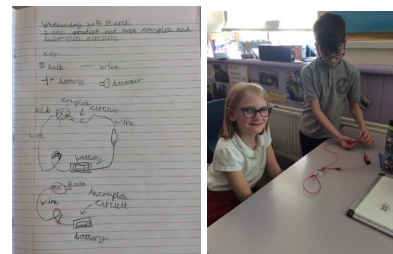
The children then gave it a star rating out of 5!



Puffins class

In science we have been learning about electricity. This week we have created complete and incomplete circuits. Current electricity is the flow of electrical charge through materials. Every complete circuit must have a power supply. The power supply could be the mains, or it could be a battery.

For a circuit to be complete, there must be wires connected to both the positive and negative ends of the power supply. Electricity can only flow around a complete circuit that has no gaps. We used symbols to represent the battery, bulb and wires. We drew a complete and an incomplete circuit.



Buzzards class

Buzzards have had a creative week, deducing facts from Sikh artefacts and developing our drawing and painting skills by preparing images to share with you all at our Easter celebration next Friday.



We had a great Forest School session this week. We chose from two activities: clay tree faces and creating obstacle courses. We had opportunities to view the natural art created and have a go at the obstacle courses, which had us scrambling under tarpaulins, jumping branches, pulling ourselves up banks and weaving between obstacles. 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Non-attendance at school without authorisation

All parents/carers have a legal duty to ensure that their child receives a suitable education. If you decide to take your child out of school, without approval/permission, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may refer the matter to Cornwall Council who as the issuing officer may decide to take legal action against you. A penalty notice can be issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Fines are issued per parent/carer, per child. Failure to pay the penalty notice may result in Court action. Persistent absences not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates Court, leading to fines up to £2,500 and/or custodial sentences.
